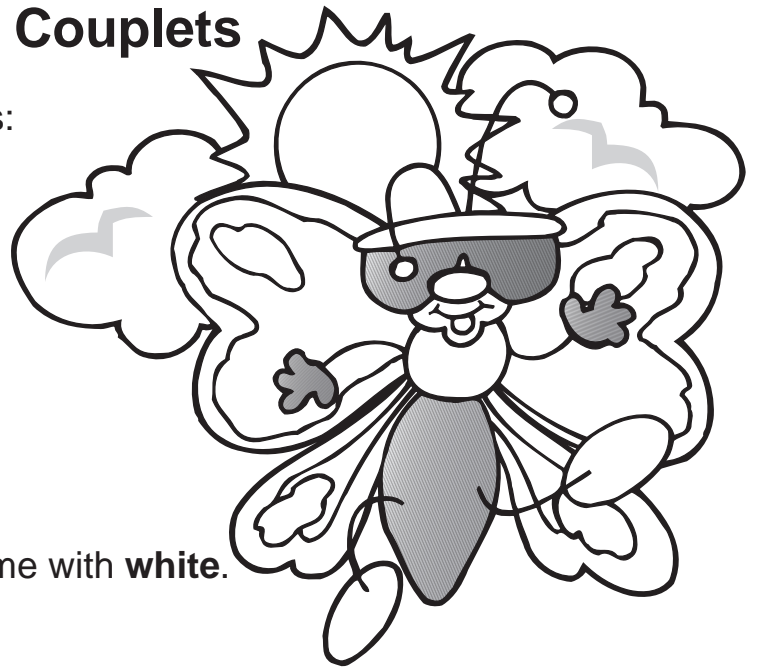


Creative Couplets

A **couplet** is a two-line poem that rhymes:

The butterfly's wings were so **bright**,
They glimmered in the sun's **light**!



The lines of this poem end with words that rhyme (**bright, light**).
